

Clean and Care of Blanket

- ▶ To protect against electrical hazards, do not immerse plug or unit in water or other liquid.
- ▶ Do not use bleach on the blanket.
- ▶ Do not dry clean or place in washing machine.
- ▶ Wash with a damp cloth only and allow to dry thoroughly before storage.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- ▶ Do not use this blanket on infants, or anyone incapable of unplugging the blanket without assistance. Do not use on anyone insensitive to heat.
- ▶ To protect against electrical hazards, do not immerse charger, adapters, or unit in water or other liquid.
- ▶ Close supervision is necessary when used by or near children.
- ▶ Do not use blanket for applications other than its intended use.
- ▶ Unplug blanket and power pack when not in use.
- ▶ Never wrap cord around blanket as this may damage cord.
- ▶ Never use AC current to power the blanket.
- ▶ The blanket is NOT machine washable. Wash with a damp cloth only and allow to dry thoroughly before storage.
- ▶ Use this appliance with your engine on to avoid draining your battery (never leave engine running in enclosed or poorly ventilated area).
- ▶ Always inspect unit before using. Do not use if unit or cords are damaged.

Before Using Portable Power Pack

- ▲ Completely charge your Power Pack before using for the first time.
 - ▲ Test battery level by pushing "Battery Indicator". Green light means battery is fully charged. Red light means battery is low and needs to be recharged.
 - ▲ Before recharging from an AC outlet be sure the source is 110 volts and not 220 volts.
 - ▲ Use only the chargers provided with unit.
- For AC Charging at Home
- Insert the AC charger cord into the charging jack of the Power Pack and plug charger into any standard 110 outlet.
- For DC Charging in Your Vehicle
- Insert the cigarette lighter plug at the end of the DC charger cord into the 12-volt socket on the unit and plug other end of charger into your vehicle cigarette lighter socket.
- ▲ Initial charge may take 24 hours.

RoadPro recommends recharging only while vehicle is running as not to drain battery.

Never leave vehicle running in a poorly ventilated area.

Using Your Portable Power Supply as Car Starter

- ▲ Open the compartment of the power pack and remove DC cord.
- ▲ Plug the cord into your vehicle's cigarette lighter socket.
- ▲ Turn switch on Power Pack to "Car Starter".
- ▲ Wait one minute before attempting to start engine. Please note Power Pack will not jump start a completely dead battery or vehicle with electrical problems.
- ▲ Do not start vehicle in poorly ventilated area.

Using Your Portable Power Pack with Blanket

- ▲ Unfold blanket and check for any visible signs of damage.
- ▲ Insert the blanket's DC power plug into the 12-Volt socket on the side of the Portable Power Supply and turn switch to "12-Volt Socket" position.
- ▲ The blanket will automatically maintain a warm comfortable temperature during use.

Using Your Portable Power Pack with Other 12-Volt Accessories

The Portable Power Supply has a output limit of 10 amps...do not use your power accessories that require higher amperage.

- ▲ Insert the accessory's DC power plug into the 12-Volt socket on the side of the Portable Power Pack and turn switch to "12-Volt Socket" position.
- ▲ Turn on accessory and begin operation. Running time will vary from accessory to accessory.

The Portable Power Supply has a output limit of 10 amps..

do not use you power accessories that require higher amperage.
